

General help sheet and instructions for forms

1 Procedure to get network access

1. Please read these instructions thoroughly!
2. Complete two versions of the membership application form and one version of the services form. The forms are explained in more detail below.
3. Put the forms into one of our mailboxes in Wundtstraße 5 (located at the bottom right), Borsbergstraße 34, Hochschulstraße 46 (basement) or Hochschulstraße 48. Alternatively, you can bring them in person to one of our offices (Wundtstraße 5, ground floor, or Borsbergstraße 34, 7th floor, Hochschulstraße 46, basement) during office hours. Usually they will be processed there immediately.
4. Usually no later than a week after submitting your application you will receive your personal copy including your access information for our other services. By then you should be able to access the internet.
5. Make sure your mailbox is properly labelled so that we can deliver your copy of the application.

2 Form instructions for 'Mitgliedschaftsantrag'

Tip: There is an English translation of the 'Mitgliedschaftsantrag' on page 2 of this help. However, this version is not valid as an application form since it was not legally verified, yet. You can use it as reference for completing the German version, though.

Desired username You are free to pick any username according to the listed limitations.

With your username you can log in to our website and the other services we offer. For this you need a password, which you get after the registration. You are, of course, free to change the password later anytime.

Furthermore the username is the local part of the email address that you receive: <name>@wh2.tu-dresden.de

Forward e-mails to (optional) Important announcements and notifications regarding your account are sent via email. We **strongly** recommend you to set up an email address for forwarding if you do not intend to use your AG DSN email account. This is possible via our website.

3 Form instructions for 'Access to additional services'

3.1 MAC address





To get connection to the network, you must provide a so called MAC address. Each network card has a unique identifier, the so called MAC, Ethernet or physical address. It is a twelve-digit hexadecimal number (digits 0-9, letters a-f), often divided by hyphens or colons. Example: 00:12:6B:9F:20:CC. **Note:** Only the one device registered via its MAC address is able to establish a connection from your room and your IP address. If you want to connect multiple devices or use WiFi, use a router! (See subsection 4.3!)

3.1.1 Getting the LAN MAC address of a PC


The easiest way of finding this address is by connecting to the socket on the wall and accessing <http://agdsn.de> in your browser (Firefox, Chrome or similar). You should now be presented a blue error page displaying your MAC address. Copy this to your form. If this doesn't work, try out the according method below.

Please note that most computers have multiple network cards/adapters (maybe even virtual ones). We need the address of the Ethernet adapter or Local Area Network connection.




Windows

1. Press  + .
2. Type `cmd` and .
3. Type `getmac /v` and .
4. Find the Ethernet adapter. (Not WLAN or WiFi!)
5. Read the physical address.

Linux

1. Open a terminal and type `ifconfig -a` and .
2. Read ether or HWaddr of the Ethernet interface (`eth0`, `em0`, `r10` or similar).

Mac OS X 10.5 or later

1.  >> System Preferences >> Network >> Ethernet
2.  >> Hardware >> MAC Address or  >> Ethernet >> Ethernet-ID

3.1.2 Getting the WAN MAC address of a router



The MAC address printed on the backside of most routers is not the one required for the network connection. We need the one of the WAN port, which you should find in the device's configuration interface. For more information please refer to the router's manual.






4.1 Connecting to the Network

To obtain access please connect your device with a RJ45 cable to the labelled socket. Make sure that you obtain the network configuration automatically:

Mac OS X 10.5 or later

1.  >> System Preferences >> Network >> Ethernet
2.  >> Using DHCP

Windows 2000 or later

1. Press  + .
2. Type `control netconnections` and .
3.  your Local Area Connection.
4.  >> Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)
5.  >> Obtain an IP Address automatically

4.2 Membership contribution

Every member has to pay a contribution (currently 5 EUR), which is due at the end of each month. However, we recommend paying 30 EUR for the whole semester **in advance**. After 14 days of outstanding payments you may be excluded from our services, after 62 you may lose your membership status.

You can find your user ID on the access data sheet, that will be delivered to you a few days after you've submitted your application, or the traffic overview page on our website.

4.3 Multiple Devices/WiFi

If you want to use multiple devices or WiFi, you have to use a (WiFi) router. Please **avoid** buying an access point or DSL router. These devices typically do not operate as a normal router and won't work. Our website lists a few models that work for sure.

5 Further information

Changing the MAC address You can change your MAC address via our website. Alternatively, you can tell us the new address (see Contact).

Moving out temporarily If you move out temporarily, e.g. for an internship or a semester abroad, please let us know and that you want to resign for this period (see Contact). During your absence, you will no longer be a member and thus won't have to pay the contribution. When you are back, you have to apply again for membership and specify your old User-ID, if you had one.

Subtenants You pay for your membership - not for the network access. Therefore subtenants must become members themselves and are not allowed to simply use the main tenant's network access. Keep in mind: If you let someone else use your network access, you are liable in first place for their actions.

Moving If you are moving please fill the form "Umzugsbenachrichtung" and give it to us.

Moving out/Resign Please brief us when you move out and/or want to resign (see Contact).

Contact If you have any questions or problems, write an email to support@agdsn.de, approach an admin in your dormitory directly (refer to the poster in your dormitory if available) or come to our opening hours on Mondays and Thursdays at our offices at the ground floor of Wundtstraße 5 (from 7 to 8pm), on the seventh floor of Borsbergstraße 34 (from 8pm to 9pm) or in the basement of Hochschulstraße 46 (from 7pm to 7:30pm). Office hours may change during semester break, please see our website or posted notices at our office.

6 Other Services

Besides access to the student network, your membership allows you to access additional services, like an email account, webspace with a MySQL database, SSH login and many more. Find out more on our website.

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Information on our privacy policy for members

This is an overview about how we process your personal data and your rights regarding it defined by the respective data protection laws. The details about collection, processing and usage of your data follows below.

2 Collected Data

We collect and process the following data:

- Name, postal address, duration of your membership and financial transactions are collected for accounting and tax purposes due to UStG §14b till 10 years after the end of your membership.
- Your user name is saved to identify you till you end your membership.
- The email address we provide you with is saved without relation to your person for 10 years after the end of your membership to prevent others from getting the same address.
- If you have configured email forwarding, we save the destination address for the time of your membership.
- Data inside the provided services webspace (incl. home directory), databases, virtual servers and email are saved for the time of your membership to provide the respective service.
- Your MAC and IP address are required to provide you network access and are saved as long as you use this service.
- Your IP address, date of birth and everything mentioned under point 1 is saved due to TKG §111 for the time you use the provided network access.
- Your traffic statistics (exclusively transmitted data volumes) of the last 7 days and your accumulated traffic credit are saved as long as you use the provided network access.
- If you have activated the HTTP cache, anonymous usage statistics are collected.
- In security-related incidents, it is possible to record network traffic and secure it until the incident is cleared up.
- Support tickets are saved for 1 year after the last contact with you to provide you with better diagnostics and help.

This data is processed, if not additionally explicitly mentioned with the individual data, with the following legal bases:

- The data mentioned under point 1 and 2 is collected in accordance with GDPR art. 6 par. 1 b.
- The data mentioned under point 3 to 11 is collected in accordance with GDPR art. 6 par. 1 a.

3 Processing and access control

The data mentioned above is processed and saved electronically and/or print. All data is stored in the AG DSN's data processing system. All data is deleted after receiving an introduction about the proper data protection procedures in accordance to Saxony privacy law (SächsDSG).

3.1 Automated decision making

The data mentioned under point 9, your financial data and external abuse allegations may be used to automatically block and unblock your network access.

3.1.1 Block for outstanding contributions

If you have not transferred the contribution in time, your access to services of AG DSN will be blocked. The block will be lifted after your arrears have been settled. After a longer delay in payment the membership will be terminated automatically.

You can find information regarding the exact grace period before being blocked or having your membership terminated in our finance regulation.

3.1.2 Block for exceeding traffic quota

You have a certain traffic quota available for use. If you caused more traffic than your quota allowed, your network access is blocked until your credit is greater than zero again. This is checked once a day.

4 Data sharing

If required by law (e.g. UHG §101 Abs. 9 or TKG §112, §113) we will provide collected information to entitled third parties. If you violate the Rahmenvorgabe defined by the ZfH or the usage agreement with the DFN, your data may be shared with them.

5 Your rights

You have the following rights:

- the right to receive a copy of your data according to GDPR art. 15
- the right to rectification of your data according to GDPR art. 16
- the right to erasure of your data according to GDPR art. 17
- the right to restrict the processing of your data according to GDPR art. 18
- the right to transfer your data according to GDPR art. 20
- the right to object according to GDPR art. 21

According to DSGVO art. 77 you have the right of appeal to the appropriate data protection supervisory authority.

You can withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data at any time. This right of withdrawal also applies to consent you have given before the DSGVO's commencement (Friday 25th May, 2018). Please note that your revocation is effective only for the future, i.e. data processing done before your revocation will not be affected. Please direct your withdrawal to the above-mentioned data protection officer.

5.1 Your right to object

- If you object to the collection and processing of your data as described under point 1 and 2, your membership will end immediately.
- If you object to the collection and processing of your data as described under point 3 to 10, we can not provide you with the respective services any longer.
- If you object to the collection and processing of your data as described under point 11, the support quality we can provide you may suffer.
